

Mount Gimie is the tallest mountain on the island of Saint Lucia. The mountain's peak reaches 950 m. It is of volcanic origin and is covered by lush tropical rainforest.

Gros Piton is one of two mountains south of the town Soufrière in the southwest of Saint Lucia. Lying at the southern end of Pitons Bay, it rises to a height of 786 m. It is the second highest peak on Saint Lucia, after Mount Gimie.

Petit Piton lies towards the middle of the bay, south of the town of Soufrière and north of the larger mountain, Gros Piton, to which it is linked by the Piton Miton Ridge. Petit Piton rises to a height of 739 m.
